

PURCHASED EQUIPMENT ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH & SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

As a company operating in the United States, nLIGHT desires to install and operate equipment in a safe manner and in compliance with local, state and federal regulations. Therefore, the following documentation, whenever applicable, must be provided with the equipment specified on this purchase order:

- Installation instructions including lifting procedures and seismic bracing for heavy items;
- Safety Data Sheets (SDSs) for each hazardous material supplied with, contained within, or necessary for the maintenance of the equipment;
- Notification of Ozone Depleting Substances contained within the equipment;
- Restriction of Hazardous Substances (RoHS) compliance;
- User manual (including requirements for safe operation and maintenance);
- Lockout/Tagout (LOTO) points;
- Decommissioning procedures.

In addition, electrical equipment must be accepted by the Occupational Safety & Health Administration (OSHA) and the Authority Having Jurisdiction (AHJ). To be accepted, the electrical equipment must be approved by a Nationally Recognized Testing Laboratory (NRTL) per provisions of the OSHA General Industry Standards (Part 1910 of Title 29, Code of Federal Regulations).

If it is determined that the equipment purchased and represented as “Accepted” is not, then the supplier will bear the burden of cost to achieve acceptance through a field inspection/evaluation in order to allow nLIGHT to be in compliance.
